### Hunter Valley Gardens

Nestled at the foothills of the Brokenback Ranges, in the heart of the Hunter vineyards, you will find the magnificent Hunter Valley Gardens - over 60 acres of spectacular international display gardens that will amaze you with sensational sights, colours, fragrances and adventures.

### Dolphin & Whale Watch Tours

Something to spout about...with over 140 bottlenose dolphins calling Port Stephens home, it's no wonder these friendly locals are sighted so often. And, from May to November, the waters off Port Stephens play host to the magnificent migrating humpback whales.

### Newcastle Memorial Walk

Breathe in the fresh air and stroll the Newcastle Memorial Walk, a 450m walkway traversing the cliff top from Strzelecki Lookout to Bar Beach. A tribute to local men and women whom have served at war, the walk incorporates interpretive signage and memorials along the way, and boasts spectacular views of the city and ocean. This is also popular spot for an early morning or evening walk among locals, and for whale spotting during migration season (June to November).

## DAY ONE

### Morning



#### CENTRAL COAST

Take a break and get up close and personal with Australian animals at the Australian Reptile Park.

### Lunch



#### HUNTER VALLEY

Enjoy lunch at one of the many restaurants or cafes located at a winery.

### Afternoon



Arrive at the Hunter Valley Gardens and explore Australia's largest display garden, spanning over 60 acres of 10 stunning themed gardens.

### Overnight



Stay the night at one of the hotels set within the vineyards of the Hunter Valley.

## DAY TWO



### Morning

#### PORT STEPHENS

Explore the Worimi Conservation Lands the largest moving sand dunes in the Southern Hemisphere. Enjoy a unique and exhilarating Beach and Dune Tour to see how people live on the dunes at Tin City and observe the pippa habitats as well as catching and releasing them.



### Lunch

Enjoy fresh barramundi straight from the farm at Cookabarra Restaurant at Bobs Farm. The hydroponic vegetable farm growing fresh produce on-site is served fresh on the plate.



### Afternoon

Learn about the local population of dolphins or the majestic whales on your dolphin or whale watching cruise. You can see the dolphins all year round and the whales May to November.



### Overnight

Port Stephens has a range of accommodation to offer. Try the fantastic holiday parks which offer self-contained cabins close to the waterfront.

## DAY THREE



### Morning

#### NEWCASTLE

Absorb spectacular views of the city and ocean on Newcastle Memorial Walk. This 450m walkway traverses the cliff top from Strzelecki Lookout to Bar Beach and is a tribute to local men and women whom have served at war. Cool off after your walk and take a dip at nearby Bar Beach.



### Lunch

Enjoy lunch and a drink at one of the many popular cafes and restaurants at Honeysuckle, perched on the edge of one of the busiest ports in the world.



### Afternoon

After lunch head back towards Sydney enjoying a detour to take in the daily 3:30pm pelican feeding at The Entrance.
